



Incidents of Racism

At Stanley Road Primary School we take any incident of Racism very seriously. The following procedure is in place:

- Any allegation of racism is fully investigated by teachers and the Lead Behaviour Professional, Mrs Tracey, is informed.
- Once the allegation is found to be correct, a suitable consequence is put in place. This may involve missing a number of break times and lunchtimes. During this loss of privilege the child will be expected to complete a piece of work on the subject of racism appropriate to the age of the child.
- Parents will be informed of the behaviour.
- A racist incident form will be sent to the LA.
- Details of the racist incident will be recorded on our behaviour data system.
- It may be considered appropriate for the child to attend sessions in the Crystal room.
- The victim of the racist incident will be supported. This may take the form of a chat or if it is felt appropriate they may also attend sessions in the Crystal room.
