



Trips and Visits Curriculum

At Stanley Road, we plan a sequence of trips and visits which serve two purposes...

1. To directly support learning in the curriculum. The trip helps pupils to know more and remember more about the content they are studying in school.
2. To provide a range of experiences that support the development of pupils' cultural capital

Year Group	Location	Purpose
Reception	Smithills Farm	Pupils undertake a study of farming and animals in Reception which is supported by a trip to the farm. This experience helps them to remember the content of the curriculum and use the vocabulary they have learned in school.
Year 1	Blackpool Zoo	Pupils undertake a study of animals as part of their science curriculum work. This learning is further embedded by visiting a zoo and seeing the animals they have learned about up close.
Year 2	Lytham St Annes	Pupils undertake a study of coasts as part of their geography curriculum work. This learning is supported by visiting Lytham. They also benefit from the experience of visiting a contrasting locality to Oldham and experience playing on a beach.
Year 3	Ribchester Roman Fort	Pupils undertake a study of the Romans in Britain as part of their History curriculum. The trip to Ribchester ensures pupils apply their knowledge of Roman life as they take part in the workshops and discuss the artefacts on display.
Year 4	Bolton Museum – Egyptian Exhibit and Aquarium	Pupils undertake a depth study of the Ancient Egyptians as part of their History curriculum. This visit ensures pupils have the chance to view and discuss artefacts from this period including human and cat mummies. Alongside the opportunity to review knowledge from their Egyptian work, there is also an aquarium which gives pupils a valuable opportunity to see a range of aquatic animals close up.
Year 5	Hollingworth Lake (Adventure and Water Activity Centre)	Pupils have the opportunity to develop their water confidence and take part in a kayaking activity. This is a valuable experience that many of our pupils would not typically access otherwise.
Year 6	Theatre Trip End of year trip	Pupils access the rich cultural experience of attending a professional theatre production at a major theatre in Manchester. This experience broadens their horizons and we hope gives them the confidence and desire to attend theatre productions in the future. The end of year trip is an opportunity to celebrate pupils' achievements in primary school and mark their transition to secondary school. In the past this has included trips to a restaurant, cinema and activity centre.
