	aviator	a person who operates an aircraft, a pilot



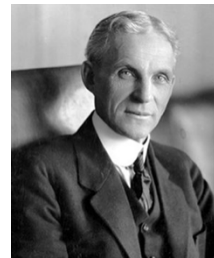

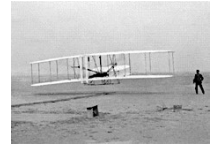
