Segregation	Enforced separation of different groups of people.
Ancestors	Someone who was related to you a long time ago.
Race	A group of people who share the same culture.
Gender	Being male (a man) or female (a woman).
Religion	The belief in and worship of a god.
Governess	A woman employed to teach children in someone's house.
Protest	Expressing that you do not agree with something.
Vote	Being able to choose what you would prefer to happen.
Civil rights	The rights of citizens for freedom and equality.
Boycott	When you refuse to use something as a form of protest.
